- 180" tall (diameter of wheel is 171' 2 9/16")
- Visible from the top: Washington Monument, U.S. Capitol, Alexandria, Prince George's County
- Number of Climate-Controlled Gondolas: 42 (including National Harbor One, the VIP gondola)
- Maximum Number of Passengers: 336 (up to 8 per Gondola)
- Projected Annual Number of Passengers: 600,000 to 800,000
- Weight of Wheel Structure (fully erected): approximately 320 tons (does not include the base); additional weight from the base grid is 140 tons
- Price (plus tax): \$15 per ride (National Harbor One will cost more)

- 1500 lbs. each
- Approximately 6' long x 5' wide x 5' high
- Climate controlled with AC (summer operation) and heat (winter operation)
- Will hold 1380 lbs. and up to 8 people
- Made in Switzerland
- Glass Exterior
- Interior lights
- National Harbor One has glass floors, wine chillers, retracting monitor/DVD player and leather bucket seats
- All gondolas have two-way communication with the operator individually

LEGS

- 8 legs on The Capital Wheel
- The axle which sits at the top of the support legs is 95'
- Bears 145,000 lbs. on base structure
